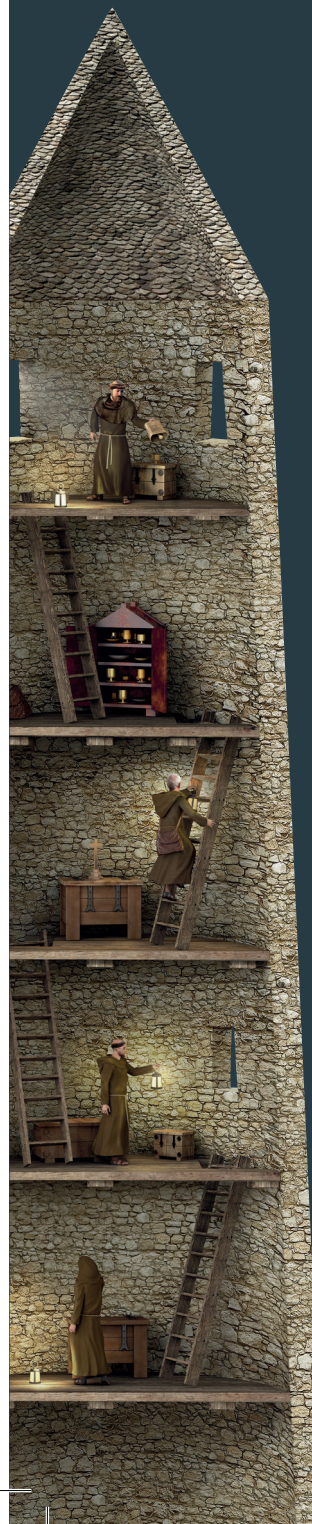

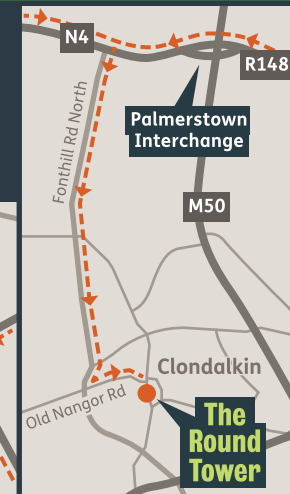


How to find us

LUAS

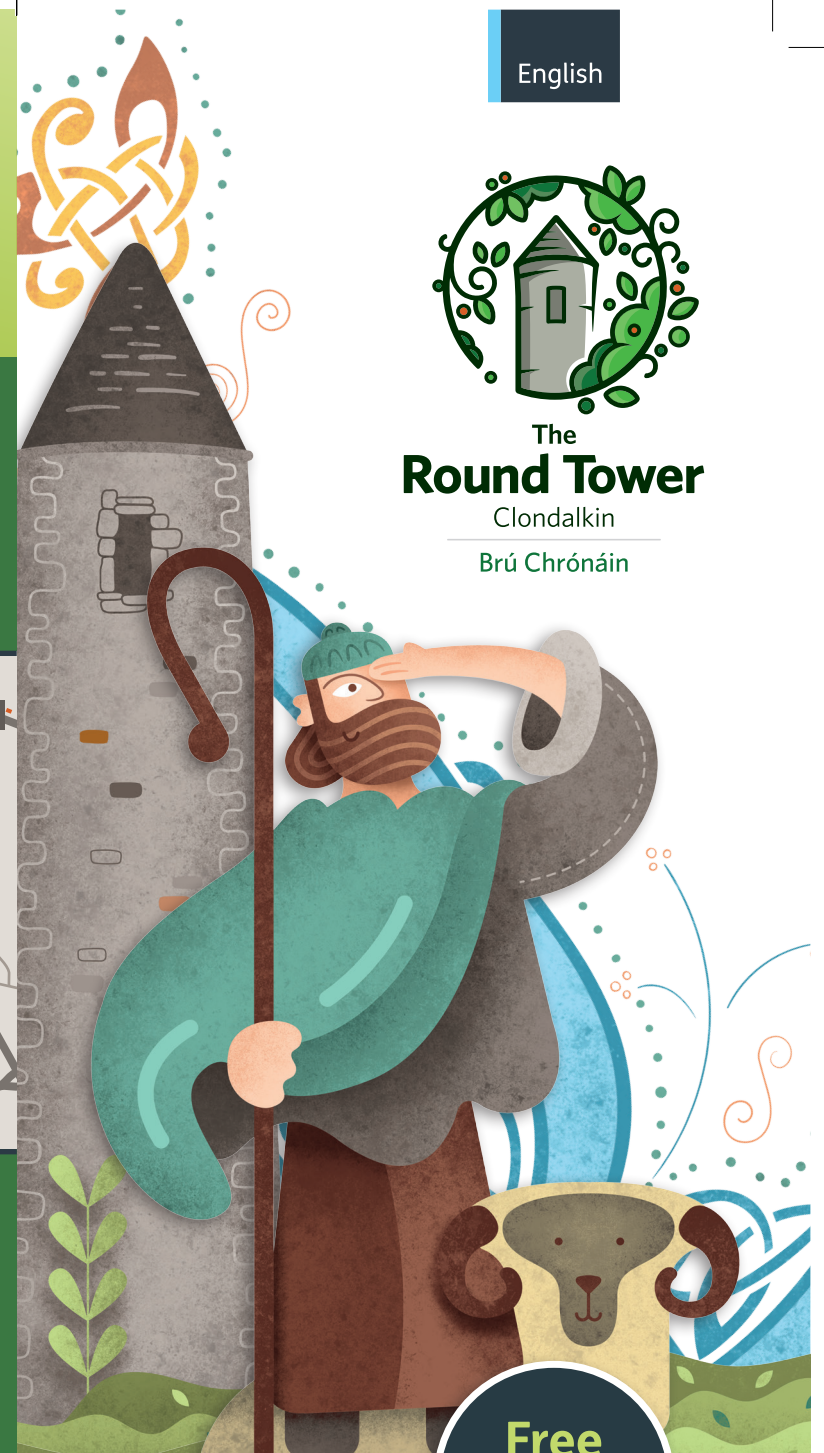
The LUAS stops at **The Red Cow**, approximately 25 mins walk to the Centre via Monastery Road.
